



## **Mexico Tourist Card**



Non US Citizens should research their country's Visa Requirements.

For US Citizens, a Tourist Card is required for anyone entering Mexico as a tourist and staying for more than 72 hours. If you arrive to Mexico by plane the tourist card is generally included in the price of your airline ticket and issued upon your arrival. If however, you are driving to Mexico you must obtain a Tourist Card. It is your responsibility to obtain a Tourist Card.

The Tourist Card will cost you approximately \$20 US (depending on the exchange rate.)
